0	Check your status on the financial aid online portal to see if you have received need-based aid and/or have been deemed eligible for merit- or talent-based scholarships. Notification of aid will be posted at the same time as your admission decision. If you were anticipating need-based aid, please make sure all aid documents have been submitted to complete the aid process. If you have questions, please contact the Office of Financial Aid.
	Be sure to withdraw your admission applications from other colleges and notify them of your decision to enroll at Muhlenberg.
