- ❑ To confirm your enrollment, you can sign and submit the following items through your Muhlenberg Application Status Portal:

 - ❑ \$400 nonrefundable enrollment deposit

Your enrollment deposit will be applied to your student account and can be made online using a credit card or ACH payment.
- ❑ Check your Application Status Portal to see if you have been offered need-based aid and/or merit- or talent-based scholarships. If you were anticipating need-based aid, please make sure all aid documents have been submitted to complete the aid process. - ❑ Please visit our admitted student page at muhlenberg.edu/admitted. This page will continue to be updated in the coming months.
- ❑ Please submit the course descriptions of all classes taken at previous colleges and universities to transfer@muhlenberg.edu if you have not done so already. These are needed to provide you with a credit evaluation.

Once you have enrolled:

- ❑ After you have confirmed your enrollment with Muhlenberg, be sure to withdraw your admission applications from other colleges.
- ❑ Please submit your final transcripts to transfer@muhlenberg.edu if you have not done so already.

Your offer of admission is contingent upon the satisfactory completion of your current school work. We reserve the right to rescind an admission offer if we are made aware of dishonesty in your application or any other information that indicates your behavior is not in compliance with our Student Code of Conduct at muhlenberg.edu/socialcode.
- ❑ Access your OneLogin portal and Muhlenberg College email account. Information will be provided to you via email and your Application Status Portal.
- ❑ Complete and submit a housing questionnaire and health forms. Housing is guaranteed and required for incoming transfer students unless you are a local commuting student. Health forms are located on the OneLogin portal.
- ❑ Be on the lookout for an email from your academic advisor to schedule an advising appointment by phone or Zoom. This is the time that you will meet with a faculty advisor to select courses for the first semester and take care of other important business.
- ❑ International students starting classes in the fall can expect to receive their I-20 form by early June. We issue I-20s to all international students who have confirmed their enrollment and will contact you if additional paperwork is required.
- ❑ Watch your email for information about the Transfer Orientation Program and move-in day.
