### **Honors**

Degree recipients with outstanding scholastic records are graduated with academic honors. Those exceptional students with cumulative averages of 3.9 or higher (where A equals 4.0) are graduated summa cum laude. If the average is at least 3.7, but less than 3.9, the degree is granted magna cum laude. Those students with cumulative averages of at least 3.5, but less than 3.7, are graduated cum laude.

*The designation of Latin Honors is contingent on a graduate's final grades, which were not available prior to the commencement exercises. Inclusion of honors in this program is an estimate based upon current GPA and should not be considered an official designation.*

# ACADEMIC CEREMONY

---

## Academic Dress

The origin of academic dress can be traced to the medieval university, when robes were often necessary for warmth in the unheated halls where scholarly enclaves gathered. Today, the scholar's sweeping black gown has become a ceremonial symbol of academic distinction.

In the United States, formal guidelines for academic dress—known as the Intercollegiate Code—were initiated in 1895 and, following revision in 1932 and 1959, still provide the descriptive guidelines for interpreting ceremonial dress at an academic convocation. By stipulating design and color variations in the ceremonial robe, the Code provides a system to distinguish the academic degree, institution and field of study of the wearer.

## Degree

The shape and size of the hood and the design of the sleeves indicate the academic degree of the wearer.

- Bachelor's Degree:** Pointed sleeves; usually without hood
- Master's Degree:** Long, closed sleeves with arm slits; narrow hood
- Doctorate:** Bell-shaped sleeves; broad, draped hood

## Field of Study

The color of the hood facing identifies the field of study in which the academic degree was conferred.

- Drab:** Accounting, Business, Management
- White:** Arts, Letters, Humanities
- Copper:** Economics
- Light Blue:** Education
- Brown:** Fine Arts
- Lemon:** Library Science
- Pink:** Music
- Dark Blue:** Philosophy
- Sage Green:** Physical Education
- Golden Yellow:** Science
- Cream:** Social Studies
- Scarlet:** Theology

## Institution

The color of the lining of the hood denotes the college or university by which the degree was conferred. Examples of degree-granting institutions include:

- Muhlenberg:** cardinal and grey
- Johns Hopkins:** gold and black
- Lehigh:** brown and white
- Penn:** red and blue
- Temple:** cherry and white
- Yale:** Yale blue

## The Mace

The tradition of the mace in the academic ceremony is the result of a long evolution, from a short wooden club used in medieval hand-to-hand combat to a symbol of office carried by sergeant-at-arms in royal courts. Today, the mace serves as a symbol of college and university sovereignty. At Muhlenberg it is carried by the Marshal of the Faculty, who, as a function of her office, precedes the College President and Provost in academic procession.

The mace used in today's ceremony was presented to the College in 1966 as a gift of the Allentown Alumni Club and was designed by Allentown silversmith C. Leslie Smith. The center of the mace is a natural grain oak handle. At the top is the Luther Rose, placed there to show the debt the College owes to the Lutheran Church in America. The spurs or spikes are transformed from lethal features to an upward-facing coronet. Four major sets of symbols complete the head of the mace. One plate displays the Seal of the College, the Seal of the Muhlenberg family and a replica of the cross of the College Chapel. Another plate bears dates and places of importance in College history. A third plate features the lamp of knowledge, symbols of the Trinity, again relating the College to the Church, and other symbols representing commerce, medicine, law and the fine arts. The bottom of the mace is finished with an acorn and two oak leaves in silver, which represent the growth and strength of the College. The mace is used at all formal College functions.

## **KAREN EL-CHAAR**

Karen El-Chaar serves as the director of the Allentown Department of Parks and Recreation, which encompasses more than 2,000 acres of park land and is widely recognized as one of the largest and most extensive park systems for a city of its size.

El-Chaar is a committed citizen of the Lehigh Valley. Prior to her appointment as parks and recreation director, she spent eight years as director of the nonprofit Friends of Allentown Parks, where she helped fundraise for and enhance the reputation of the city's public recreational spaces. She has collaborated with environmental science and biology classes at Muhlenberg College and taught within the Department of Business, Management and Economics at Cedar Crest College.

El-Chaar earned her bachelor's of science in secondary education and German from East Stroudsburg University of Pennsylvania, her master's of business administration from Wilkes University and her juris doctor from Temple University School of Law.



## **DR. BENJAMIN WILFOND '81**

Dr. Benjamin Wilfond '81 is an investigator at the Treuman Katz Center for Pediatric Bioethics and a pulmonologist at Seattle Children's Hospital in Washington. He also serves as a professor of bioethics and palliative care in the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Washington School of Medicine. He founded the division of Bioethics and Palliative Care in the Department of Pediatrics, where he also served as the former division chief.

The author or co-author of more than 250 papers, Wilfond has completed scholarship and research in areas of study that include ethical and policy issues related to the fields of genetics, disability and clinical research. His most recent scholarship focuses on improving access for diverse populations to advanced medical technologies, including genomic sequencing, cellular therapeutics and home mechanical ventilation and to research on medical practices within health-care delivery systems.

Wilfond graduated from Muhlenberg College in 1981 as a philosophy and biology major. He earned his medical degree from Rutgers University, completed a residency in pediatrics at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and completed a fellowship in pediatric pulmonology and medical ethics, also at the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

On campus, Burns was an Orientation Team Leader in Fall 2021, selecting and training orientation leaders for the first-year and sophomore orientation programming, as well as an Orientation Leader the previous year. She has been involved with the Office of Community Engagement in a variety of roles: She served as co-president of the Best Buddies program, which pairs people with and without intellectual disabilities in one-on-one friendships, and as vice president of Magical Memories, helping coordinate volunteers who dress as characters—from superheroes to movie characters to imaginary beings—to visit local schools and health-care settings to engage young people in a moment of magic.

Burns is a member of the Red Door Dialers, strengthening the relationship between Muhlenberg alumni, parents, donors and friends while generating philanthropic support for the College. She directed several theatre pieces for the campus and local community through the Muhlenberg Theatre Association. Burns is also a member of the women's ultimate frisbee team, the Flying Squirrels.

Burns worked with the nonprofit For The Many as a fundraising intern and then a fundraising team coach. The New York-based organization seeks to create lasting policy changes in housing, healthcare, racial justice, climate and energy and more.

With plans to attend law school after graduation, Burns will be studying for the LSAT while working at a children's theatre camp near her hometown over the summer.

Hark is a student-athlete on the golf team, a member of the Muhlenberg Athletics Leadership Team and a co-founder

of Head in the Game, a mental health organization with a mission to support student-athletes. During meetings, the group opens with a meditation, shares their experiences (with coaches, teammates and performance issues) and sometimes hears from educational guest speakers and/or members of other student groups focused on mental health.

Hark has served as vice president and as president of Muhlenberg's chapter of Alpha Epsilon Pi, an international Jewish fraternity, and he is also a founding member. The chapter began recruiting his sophomore year. To become chartered, the group needed to raise philanthropy money and grow continuously each semester, even through the disruption of the COVID-19 pandemic. The fraternity was chartered last fall. At the 2022 Honors Convocation, Hark received the Greek Leader of the Year Award. He has also served as an Orientation Leader and an Orientation Team Leader, a tour guide, a member of the student conduct board and a trip leader for the Rock Climbing Club.

Hark earned the 2021 Dr. Robert S. Ochner Award, which is awarded to a rising senior with a major grade point average of 3.5 or better who is involved in extracurricular campus and/or community organizations, plans to matriculate into a graduate program and has a recommendation from the Office of the Dean of Students. Also in 2021, Hark completed a research assistantship with Director of Counseling Services Tim Silvestri '91 related to performance psychology.

Merlo received the Chris '04 P'09 and Bonnie Getz P'09 Endowed Scholarship. He also received the Dr. George A.

Frounfelker Award for Excellence in Continuing Education at the 2022 Honors Convocation. He served as a tutor for biology and chemistry for three years and worked as a lab assistant for two semesters.

Merlo spent more than 150 hours volunteering in the emergency department at St. Luke's Hospital in Allentown as well as with Big Brothers, Big Sisters of the Lehigh Valley.

Merlo, who had graduated from New York University with a degree in finance, worked in the world of finance for 13 years, first at JPMorgan in investment banking and then within regional banking at TD Bank. But, he found himself wishing he had more of an impact on people's lives and noticed his lifelong interest in science, health and medicine returning.

Merlo, who said he was initially anxious about the dramatic career change, said he found support, encouragement and belonging at the Muhlenberg School of Graduate and Continuing Education. Launching the next chapter in his career by starting from scratch with introductory science courses, Merlo found that his initial expectations of pursuing a job as a physician's assistant soon widened to include thoughts of medical school.

After graduation, Merlo will be attending the Temple/St. Luke's School of Medicine in Bethlehem, where he's most interested in pursuing a primary-care track.

In June, he will marry his fiancée, whom he thanks for her strong and enduring support as he returned to pursue a new educational journey.
